# SAP Business One Data Transfer Workbench 2005

## 1 Introduction

### 1.1 Purpose

This document describes how to install the SAP Business One Data Transfer Workbench. The Data Transfer Workbench is an application that can be used to move legacy data easily into your SAP Business One system.

## 2 Installation – Step by Step

### 2.1 Prerequisites

- You have installed SAP Business One 2005.
- You have installed SAP Business One DI API 2005.



To get the DI API online help, you can do one of the following:

- Install the SAP Business One SDK within the optional components of the SAP Business One Client software to get the DI API documentation and samples. For more information, see the *SAP Business One Installation Guide*.
  - Downloaded the SDK DI API online help from [www.sdn.sap.com](http://www.sdn.sap.com) (Choose SAP Business One on the left. Under Help, located on the right, choose SDK 2005 Help Center. Choose Help Center to download the zip file.)
- You have a local area network connection from your PC workstation to the SAP Business One Server. You have a Professional license from SAP.

For more information on licensing, see *LicenseGuide.pdf* on the SAP Business One CD.

- To install the Data Transfer Workbench on a workstation, the minimum hardware and software requirements for the workstation are:
  - Microsoft® Windows XP; Microsoft® Windows 2000 or Microsoft® Windows NT 4.0
  - Intel® Pentium
  - 128 MB RAM
  - 24-bit color display
  - 500 MB available storage space
  - Microsoft® Internet Explorer 5.5 (or higher)  
You have set the security settings for each area at **Medium** by choosing *Tools* → *Internet Options* → *Security*
  - Adobe® Acrobat Reader 5.0.5 (or higher)

## 2.2 Installing the Data Transfer Workbench



If you have installed any previous version of the Data Transfer Workbench, you should first uninstall it from your PC workstation.

To install the Data Transfer Workbench, proceed as follows:

1. Get the Data Transfer Workbench installation package from SAP product CD or download it from the SAP Service Marketplace (<http://service.sap.com>).
2. Unzip the package from the open archive to your hard drive.
3. Run the setup.exe file from the location you have unzipped the package.
4. In the InstallShield Wizard initial window, choose *Next*.
5. To confirm the installation path, in the *Choose Destination Location* window, choose *Next*.
6. To confirm the program folder, in the *Select Program Folder* window, choose *Next*.
7. In the *Start Copying Files* window, read the setup summary. To start copying the files, choose *Next*.



At this stage, you can choose *Back* to return to the previous windows and make any necessary modifications.

The Data Transfer Workbench setup process begins.

8. When the setup process is completed, choose *Finish*.  
You have installed the Data Transfer Workbench.

## 2.3 Checking the Installation

To check the installation, proceed as follows:

1. To verify whether the path exists, on the Microsoft Windows taskbar, choose *Start* → *Programs* → *SAP Business One* → *Data Migration*.  
The *Data Migration* folder consists of three items: *Data Transfer Workbench*, *Documentation*, and *Templates*.
2. Start the Data Transfer Workbench application by choosing *Start* → *Programs* → *SAP Business One* → *Data Migration* → *Data Transfer Workbench*.

The Data Transfer Workbench application starts running.

## 3 License and License Server

Before using the Data Transfer Workbench, in the logon window of the Data Transfer Workbench, you must specify the license server and append the port number to the license server name (for example, `<LicenseServerName>:30000`).

## 4 Uninstalling the Data Transfer Workbench

To uninstall the Data Transfer Workbench, use the Microsoft Windows *Add/Remove Programs* function.

## 5 Help from SAP

If you have any problems with the Data Transfer Workbench, go to the SAP Service Marketplace (<http://service.sap.com>) and open a message in the component **SBO-DTW**.
